### **PRIME CATTLE (15) Auctioneer: Roger Waters**

Miss Jones strikes double top with her pair of homebred Limousin cross heifers taking the best butchers beast and reserve best butchers beast. The best makes the best price 210p per kilo, taken by judge Jason Wareham of Tottingworth Farms.

Congratulations to Mark and Jackie Cornwell in selling homebred Simmental cross steers at 190p twice and worthy of mention Leslie Brash's purebred Sussex at 188p. Good cattle and good trade, more wanted next week.

### **CULL COWS (12) Auctioneer: Roger Waters**

Improving trade continues, great competition around the liveweight ring - we say again many cull cows are worth more alive than they are dead - Mark and Jackie Cornwell takes the Easter Show Best Cow award with their homebred Charolais cross across the bridge at 790 kilos and topping out at 143p (£1,129.70). Charolais, Limousin and Simmental crosses all sold to feed on at 135p, 127p and 124p. Excellent demand.
