Nothing great, the trade or the entry, lacking FABBL approved non-exempt cattle. Chris Berry's heavyweight £1,000 plus. No butcher weights on offer.

Waning a little but then so is the cattle condition. Hereford crosses from Chris Berry to 114p and £1,225 per head, heavy fat Aberdeen Angus cross 85p per kilo and Holstein steakiers 85p per kilo. Many plainer cows sold for further fattening 70/75p per kilo.
