PRIME CATTLE (UNDER AGE & OVERAGE) (17) *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

Good to see more cattle on offer. Brian Ashby in top slot with his lightweight Limousin cross steers at 190p. Best of the heifers - Phil Hook's Sussex cross at 178p. Little change in overall demand.

CULL COWS (19) - *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

Cows more plentiful, little alteration in demand. Peter Nye's young smart Limousin 166p per kilo and worthy of it. Best of the Natives - Waters Partnership's Aberdeen Angus 118p and £926.30 per head. No well fleshed black and white cows on offer, big framed cows to feed on to 86p per kilo. Medium weight crossbred Jerseys 63p/65p, bigger sorts to 81p.

Customers all present and anxious to buy young beef cross calves. Only young Holstein bulls and Kiwi cross bulls on offer. Graham Smith's Holsteins to £39 and Kiwi crosses to £11! 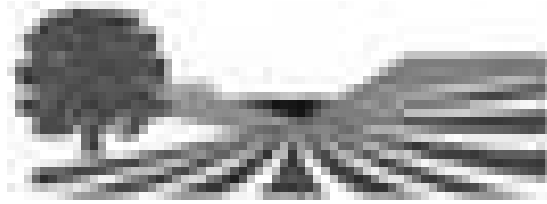
