Preliminary Announcement Veterinary Attestation

effective from 13th December 2023

Livestock being sold for slaughter will require a Veterinary Attestation number to meet EU requirements if the animal and or part of the animal is to be exported out of the UK.

VAN number

Veterinary Attestation Number known as the <u>VAN number</u> will appear on the Veterinary Attestation Certificate provided by the Vet after the annual on-farm veterinary visit which will be valid for twelve months.

Vendors who are already a member of a farm assurance scheme ie Red Tractor etc will automatically qualify because they would have had a regular annual health visit from a vet.

At the point of sale potential purchasers will be informed whether stock has a valid **VAN/Farm Assurance** number.

Stock without a valid VAN number or Red Tractor approved will not qualify for export.

VAN - The position and implementation is on-going but the foregoing is a brief summary as at today - discussions between Defra, Welsh Government, RCVS and the Livestock Auctioneers Association are continuing.

The industry fights hard to oppose Veterinary Attestation but 13th December looms - watch this space.

BLUETONGUE IS A NOTIFIABLE ANIMAL DISEASE

If you suspect it you must report it immediately by calling the

Defra Rural Services Helpline on 03000 200 301

Following routine bluetongue surveillance, a single cow has tested positive for bluetongue serotype 3 on a premises near Canterbury, Kent. A 10 km temporary control zone has been declared around the premises where the animal was kept. Movement restrictions apply to cattle, sheep and other ruminants.

Adult cattle may serve as a source of virus for several weeks while displaying little or no clinical signs of disease and are often the preferred host for insect vectors.

Signs of the disease *in cattle* include:

- lethargy
- crusty erosions around the nostrils and muzzle
- redness of the mouth, eyes, nose
- reddening of the skin above the hoof
- nasal discharge
- reddening and erosions on the teats
- fever
- milk drop
- · not eating
- abortion

Sheep are more likely to show obvious clinical signs of Bluetongue than cattle if they become infected.

Signs of the disease *in sheep* include:

- · ulcers or sores in the mouth and nose
- discharge from the eyes or nose and drooling from mouth
- swelling of the lips, tongue, head and neck and the coronary band (where the skin of the leg meets the horn of the foot)
- red skin as a result of blood collecting beneath the surface
- fever
- lameness
- breathing problems
- abortion
- death






