Veterinary Attestation Number

effective from 13th December 2023

Livestock being sold for slaughter will require a Veterinary Attestation number to meet EU requirements if the animal and or part of the animal is to be exported out of the UK.

VAN number

Veterinary Attestation Number known as the <u>VAN number</u> will appear on the Veterinary Attestation Certificate provided by the Vet after the annual on-farm veterinary visit which will be valid for twelve months.

Vendors who are already a member of a farm assurance scheme ie Red Tractor etc will automatically qualify because they would have had a regular annual health visit from a vet.

At the point of sale potential purchasers will be informed whether stock has a valid **VAN/Farm Assurance** number.

Stock without a valid VAN number or Red Tractor approved will not qualify for export.

VAN - The position and implementation is on-going but the foregoing is a brief summary as at today - discussions between Defra, Welsh Government, RCVS and the Livestock Auctioneers Association are continuing.

The industry fights hard to oppose Veterinary Attestation but 13th December looms - watch this space.

PRIME COWS (7) Auctioneer: Roger Waters

David Morris scores again double top! Homebred Limousin cross steer 265p per kg topping out at £1868.25. **Derek Crush's** Beef Shorthorn steer with shape of Blue trades at 149p per kg ie £1556.25. More wanted.

CULL COWS (18) *Auctioneer:* Roger Waters

Eighteen cull cattle forward - very much a stand on trade, once again the Sussex breed out in numbers with some excellent results. St George's Retreat Farm cows head the leader board with their smartest cow reaching 160p per kg ie £1152 per head, others at 155p, 138p per kg etc. Their well fleshed bull changes hands at £1123.20. Mrs P Watts has Sussex cows reaching £1159.20. Aged Sussex steers from Surrey County Council demonstrate the Breed capabilities weighing in at 930kg and totalling £1357, grazing the downland pasture on the North Downs. Andrew Barr's red Angus, not a Sussex, reaches 139p per kg and £938.25 per head.

Footnote:- The Pedigree Aberdeen Angus stock bull as advertised weighs in at 900kg and goes on to work at 160p per kg, £1440.

CALVES (40) Auctioneer: Roger Waters

Calves continue to come forward in better numbers - forty offered, forty sold - the prices speak for themselves. Plurenden Farm make the journey from Kent with pleasing results Hereford x bulls £220, £165, £150 etc, Hereford x heifers to £195, Aberdeen Angus x bulls £170, £130 etc. Mrs MEH Pile & Sons have British Blue x bulls to £220 and heifers to £200, Aberdeen Angus x bulls £175, £160, £150 etc and heifers to £95 twice. Lower Claverham's Aberdeen Angus x bulls £125 and £102.

Another excellent day at Hailsham. A very useful entry and dry weather. Trade for all sectors, prime lambs, store lambs and ewes, remains strong. The Chancellor in his autumn statement, despite much speculation in the media, has not abolished inheritance tax.

A very good entry with all meated lambs strongly contested. Trade is up nationally and Hailsham mirrored this for the second week running. Top call to the Shields Farming Partnership, Sidley £153 per head, also £140. Second place Mays Farm, Polegate £142; third to M Otway £141. The price per kilo stakes were completely dominated, and quite rightly so, by the Norton Farm Partnership, Seaford 292p (twice), 290p, 288p and 285p. Please make them meat and keep them coming. Good feeding and presentation are paramount.







