# Veterinary Attestation Number

*effective from 13th December 2023*

Livestock being sold for slaughter will require a Veterinary Attestation number to meet EU requirements if the animal and or part of the animal is to be exported out of the UK.

## VAN number

Veterinary Attestation Number known as the VAN number will appear on the Veterinary Attestation Certificate provided by the Vet after the annual on-farm veterinary visit which will be valid for twelve months.

Vendors who are already a member of a farm assurance scheme ie Red Tractor etc will automatically qualify because they would have had a regular annual health visit from a vet.

At the point of sale potential purchasers will be informed whether stock has a valid VAN/Farm Assurance number.

Stock without a valid VAN number or Red Tractor approved will not qualify for export.

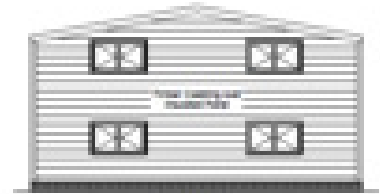

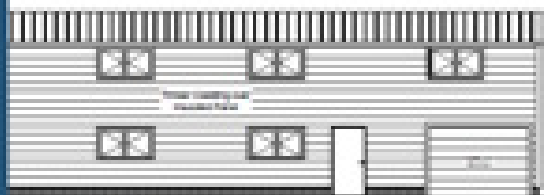

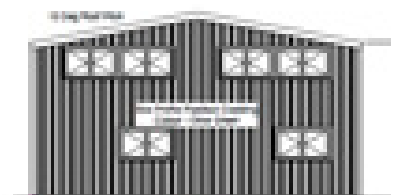
Front Elevation
