It has always been made clear by the planners that, in any application for the relocation of the present Hailsham Market, they want to see details about the relocated market and the after use of the existing site submitted simultaneously and determined together.

Due to the planners raising additional matters that require some time to satisfy, as well as recent changes in the planning procedures, it was decided that the best course of action is withdrawing the present applications and resubmitting them when the applicants can satisfy all outstanding matters.

Until then, Hailsham Market will continue to operate as usual from its existing premises in Market Street.
