

Twenty seven calves forward - dominated by two consignments of Aberdeen Angus x Jerseys selling from £5-10 per head! Clearly there must be a future to these calves when trading at this price level. On the flip side Stuart Thomas, Cooksbridge sells British Blue x heifers at £160 and Aberdeen Angus x heifers at £145. More Aberdeen Angus x Jersey calves to come in two weeks time on Wednesday 3rd April - watch this space.

Nice to see a return for the top pig breeder of West Sussex, Norman Hicks. Some good quality pigs as per usual. Trade is back this week and sell to 150p and 140p per kg with a top price of £186. In close attendance is Mr Alan Rose with his quality Durocs weighing in at 99.3kg selling at 150p per kg £149 each. Last but not least Mr Derek Crush of Ashurst tops at 105p per kg. Store pigs are still wanted - weaners wanted for next week - let us know what you have.

#### SHEEP - 1497

Yet another serious day at Hailsham in the sunshine. A big thank you to all our loyal supporters which make Hailsham achieve its true price potential week in, week out.

The live trade is certainly in front of the dead weight price.

On the international front, Australia will not permit the import of UK beef or sheep meat. The export of Australian lamb to the UK does not even need to provide an export health certificate. The same is true of Europe where the export of sheep meat from the

UK gets turned away, in particular if the temperature of the meat is too high, despite there being a specific derogation to permit this during Ramadan. The UK government export minister needs to be replaced as a matter of utmost urgency.




