1. The highest accepted bidder, subject to the Vendor's Reserve (if any) to be the Purchaser and if any dispute arises between two or more bidders the lot in dispute to be immediately put up again at the last undisputed bidding and resold, the Auctioneers to be sole arbitrators in all matters in dispute. The Auctioneers reserve the right of bidding for, withdrawing from, consolidating or dividing any lots, or varying the order of the Sale.
2. No Private Treaty Sale prior to Auction will be permitted.
3. No person to advance less than the sum named by the Auctioneers, and no bidding to be retracted.
4. The Purchasers to give in their names and places of abode, and pay down, if required, 25% of the whole of the purchase money at the fall of the hammer, in default of which the lot or lots of purchased to be immediately put up again & resold.
5. The whole of the remainder of the purchase money must be paid on or before delivery. If one person purchases two or more lots the prices of all must be paid before delivery of any. No cheques will be taken from persons unknown to the Auctioneers without a satisfactory reference or banker's guarantee. All lots to be paid for and cleared on the day of Sale.
