*Yet another big day at Hailsham.*

*Sheep from around the South East arrived and more so due to Bluetongue restrictions which prevent sheep from leaving the area.*

*The Budget has resulted in a cap on Agricultural Property Relief from Inheritance Tax at £1 million operative from April 2026, which spells disaster for many owner/occupied farms throughout the UK.*

*What can be done, if anything, to counteract this?*

An excellent entry and all meated sorts, whatever the weight, really rang the bell.

**George Harvey** was in pole position at **£160** per head; attended by **William and Petra New £155**. In the price per kilo stakes, and capturing the top three spots, were **The Norton Farm Partnership**, Seaford at 328p, 327p and 318p. At these prices it clearly pays to feed lambs and make them good meat. There is a significant margin to be had.

# BLUETONGUE VIRUS UPDATE 30/10/24

The Restricted Zone now includes East Sussex, West Sussex, Kent, Greater London, Hampshire, Nottinghamshire, Part of Leicestershire, Northamptonshire, East Riding of Yorkshire, City of Kingston upon Hull, Lincolnshire, Cambridgeshire, Bedfordshire, Hertfordshire, Buckinghamshire and part of Berkshire.

*Hailsham market is within the Bluetongue Restricted Zone - Please see the APHA Interactive Bluetongue Virus Map and our website for latest updates*

**Hailsham Market will still be operating as a livestock market**

## **Selling:**

Holdings within the restricted zone can bring stock into market to sell

Holdings from outside the restricted zone can bring stock into market to sell

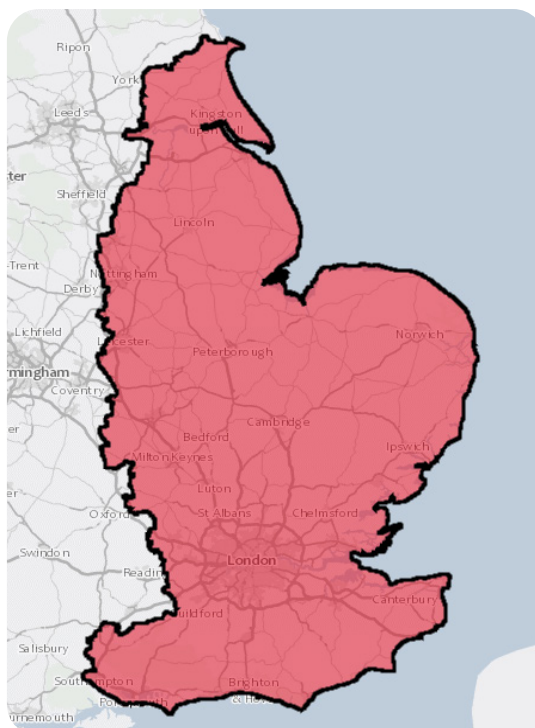
However once the stock enters the restricted zone they will not be allowed to leave the RZ unless to slaughter at an approved abattoir

## **Buying:**

Holdings from within the restricted zone can purchase stock from Hailsham market and move them freely to their holding within the restricted zone

Stock can move to any abattoir within the restricted zone

Stock can move under general license to a Blue Tongue Approved abattoir as long as the requirements on the license have been met

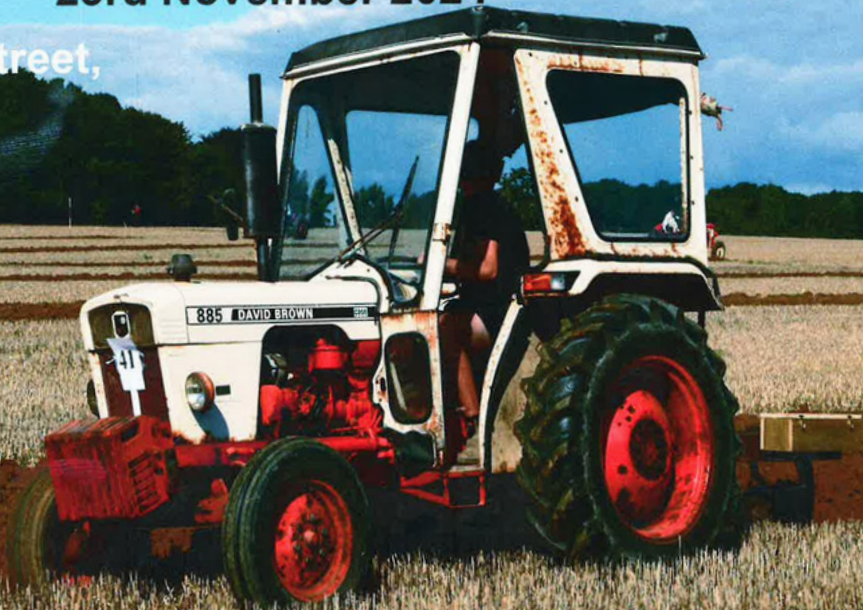
