Cambridgeshire, Bedfordshire, Hertfordshire, Buckinghamshire
and part of Berkshire.

Hailsham market is within the Bluetongue Restricted Zone -Please see the APHA Interactive Bluetongue Virus Map and our website for latest updates

Hailsham Market will still be operating as a livestock market

Selling:

Holdings within the restricted zone can bring stock into market to sell
Holdings from outside the restricted zone can bring stock into market to sell
However once the stock enters the restricted zone they will not be allowed to leave
the RZ unless to slaughter at an approved abattoir

Buying:

Holdings from within the restricted zone can purchase stock from Hailsham market and move them freely to their holding within the restricted zone

Stock can move to any abattoir within the restricted zone


Stock can move under general license to a Blue Tongue Approved abattoir as long as the requirements on the license have been met

East Sussex Farmers' Benevolent Fund






