Abattoir direct prices slipping back but auction live weight figures hold up very well - **Waters Partnership's** Bazadaise cross steers 340p and 344p per kg **£2278** and **£2109** respectively. **Tom Rea's** Aberdeen Angus x best of the heifers at 330p per kg and **£2109** per head. Still looking for more finished cattle.

CULL CATTLE (12) *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

Cull cow returns stay very firm - **Harvey Steele** takes top price per kg with his Hereford x cow at 273p per kg and grosses **£2033**. **Tom Rea's** run of crossbred British Blue cows all trade between 242p and 266p per kg, range of **£1452** to **£1755.60** and achieving an average of **£1632.54**.
