- ✓ We are offering a **nationwide delivery service free of charge** for rams only.

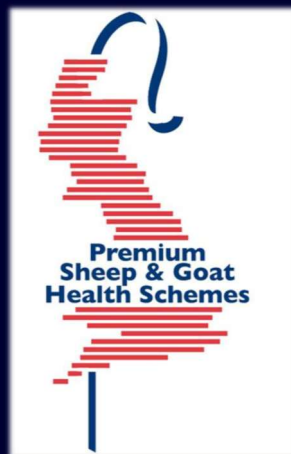


Warranty

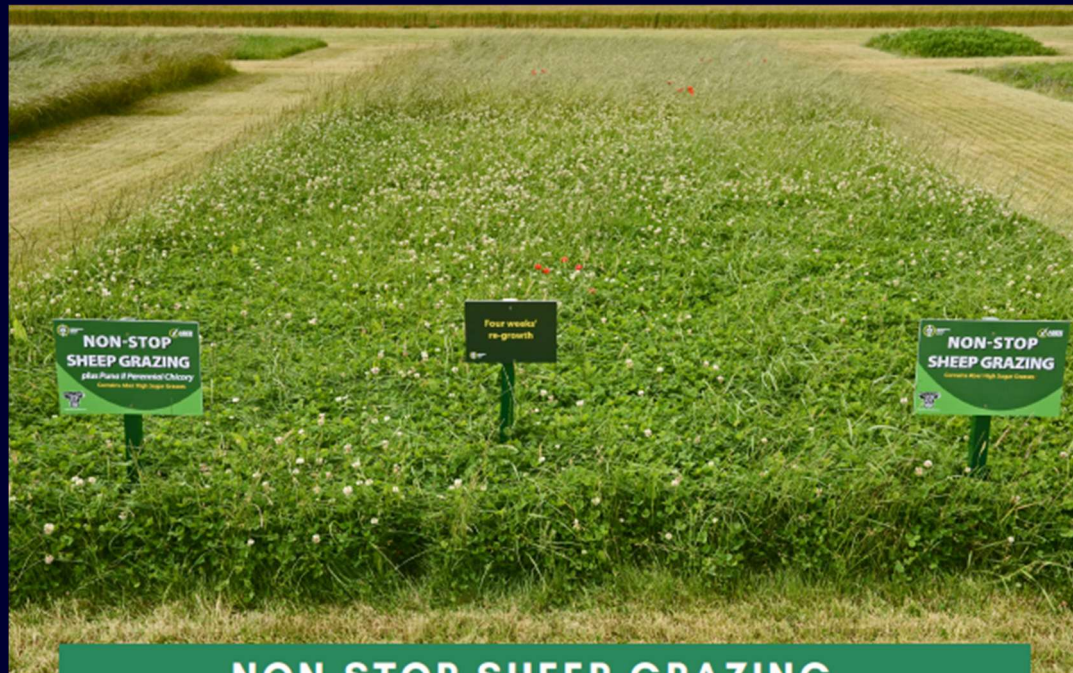

Logie Durno Sheep is a family run business in the north of Scotland. Logie Durno specialise in the production of shearling rams for the commercial and pedigree producer selling 1,000 rams annually from nine different breeds.

Logie Durno have put forward Durno and Logie rams into the sale. The Durno has been chosen because it is their most popular terminal sire, crossing well over a number of different types of ewe and is already sold to a large number of flocks in the South East of England. Durno sired lambs from these flocks are regularly among the top prices at markets in the South East. Logie rams (Lleyen x Durno) will also be offered this year for purchasers looking to breed their own replacements, whilst also producing a marketable wether lamb.



Durno Hybrid Rams – Terminal Sire

- ✓ The Durno is a **stabilised composite terminal sire** containing Texel & Charollais genetics
- ✓ Produced exclusively by Logie Durno & stabilised for 20 years
- ✓ Ensuring Durno sired lambs are consistent when crossed with commercial ewes
- ✓ **Fast growing & excellent carcass confirmation**
- ✓ Durno sired lambs grade well and are popular in the live markets

- ✓ Charollais → fast growth rates, loin depth & easy lambing
- ✓ Texel → adds hardiness, gigot muscularity and fleshing

Logie Hybrid Rams - Maternal Sire

- ✓ Logie is a **low input maternal breed**, bred for longevity and medium size whilst still producing marketable prime lambs when bred pure or crossed
- ✓ Stabilised composite maternal sire **containing Lleyn and Durno genetics**
- ✓ Produced exclusively by Logie Durno and stabilised for 20 years
- ✓ Originating from an F1 cross of the Durno and Lleyn

- ✓ Typically scan in the region of 190-200%
- ✓ The inclusion of the Durno provides **increased growth rates and conformation** whilst still retaining lambing ease and vigour to suit a low input system.

Scan Weight → Breeding potential for lamb growth rates to finishing weights

Muscle Depth → Choosing rams with high muscle depth EBVs will increase lamb muscularity & lean meat content of the carcass

Fat Depth → Ease of finishing, pick high fat depth EBV rams to improve lamb finish off grass

Index → Highlights superior breeding stock taking into account the rams individual EBVs for each trait

Fat Depth EBV: 0.51 (Top 1%)

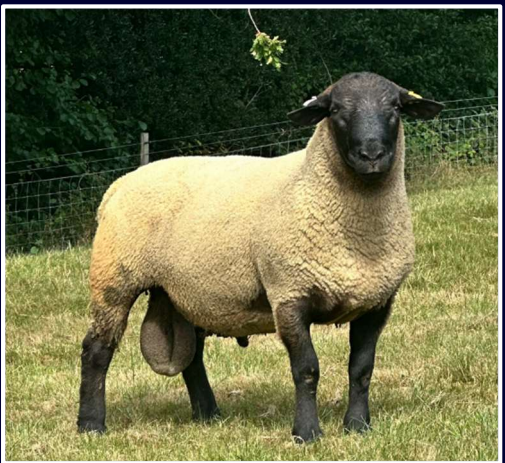

Used heavily with a lot of daughters retained, which have gone on to be productive and milky ewes. Not many unrelated ewes in the flock means we only have a few shearling rams available by him this year.

Sired by our most consistent stock ram, Sandyknowe Leader 19-1, and out of our best breeding ewe.
