They can only go direct to a slaughter house or AFU under licence.

South East Marts are happy to arrange this for you.

The only other option is to test the animal again at your cost using an interferon-gamma blood test, then if negative restrictions will be lifted.


East Sussex Farmers' Benevolent Fund
