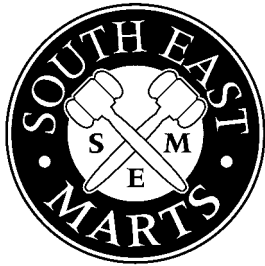
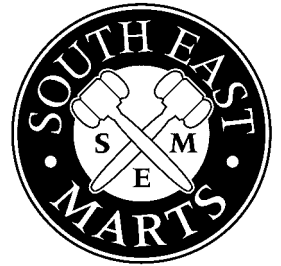

### PRIME CATTLE (17) (*UNDERAGE & OVERAGE*) **Auctioneer:** Roger Waters

*Better entry sell well* – **Tom Rea's** Sussex steers sell to **239p** per kg and grosses **£1,254**. **M & J Franklin & Son's** Aberdeen Angus cross Friesian to **220p** per kg. Cattle looking short for next week – *keep in touch*.

### CULL COWS (10) **Auctioneer:** Roger Waters

*A real flyer* – cull cows to **210p** per kg, the recent dramatic increase in values holds firm. Overall average achieved **175p** per kg and **£1,111** per head – *new ground, new values*. **Norman Hicks'** Limousins hit the high spot with **210p** per kg, others at **187p** & **177p** per kg. Best of the Native bred cows **MJ & ML McCubbine's** Hereford cross cow at **187p** and grosses **£1,243.55**.
