Top quality cattle from **Mr & Mrs James Cook** make top price. Their Simmental x heifer tops out at 248p per kilo and grosses **£1500.40**. Their Aberdeen Angus x steer trades at 229p per kilo and grossed **£1648.80**. **Wadhurst Park Estate's** purebred Sussex makes 217p per kilo and **£1269.45**. The beef trade is rock solid and we believe it will continue as we approach the Christmas period.

CULL COWS (2) *Auctioneer:* Roger Waters

Culls are short in numbers but not in price. **John Garner**, a fine country gentleman, sells Aberdeen Angus cross at 161p per kilo and **£1118.60** per head.

CALVES (28) Auctioneer: Roger Waters

Very much a stand on trade. Calf prices are considerably less than last year, but this is only to be expected with the current price of milk powder being £2590 per tonne. This time last year it was £1500 per tonne, so it is not yet double the price but heading that way. **F S Thomas's** Aberdeen Angus x bull £160 and heifer £107, British Blue heifers £147, £102. P Rossi's Aberdeen Angus bulls to £160 and heifers to £90. Lord Newton's small British Blue x bulls to £70 and heifers to £72.


