The Livestock sold is fit for human consumption and comply with the requirements of the Food Safety Act 1990 and other applicable enactments.

The holding is not under movement restriction for Bovine Tuberculosis (TB) and all animals entered for sale have been Pre-movement tested in accordance with DEFRA Bovine Movements Regulations for 1 year testing zones and where applicable, with copy of TB test certificate attached.

Cattle on the holding are not under any movement restrictions for other animal disease or public health reasons, and all stand still restrictions have been obeyed.

Unsold Fees

Cattle with a reserve that are unsold will be charged at £5 per head. Unsold rams will be charged £5 per head. Reserved unsold pedigree breeding sheep, goats and pigs will be charged at £2 per head.

Farm Assurance

To sell an animal as farm assured they must have been on a farm assured holding for a minimum of 90 days prior to the date of sale. Farm assurance certification is linked to all the holdings that an animal has been on in the last 90 days. All holding numbers that your stock will use must either be linked to your farm assurance number or have a farm assurance number in their own right. Please affix a valid farm assurance sticker on your entry form.

Ear Tag and Passport requirements
