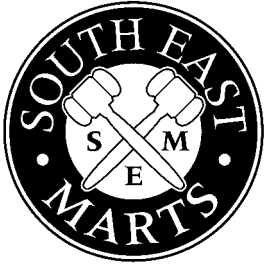
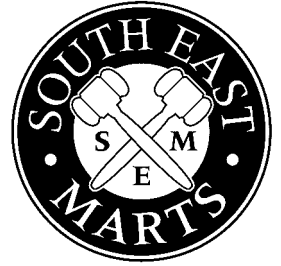

NB: They can only go direct to a slaughter house or AFU under licence.

South East Marts are happy to arrange this for you.

The only other option is to test the animal again, at your cost using an interferon-gamma blood test, then if this is negative, restrictions will be lifted.

Shame there were only two native bred finished heifers forward, both looking very well sold. Waters Partnership's medium weight **Aberdeen Angus x** 260p per kilo and grossed **£1573**. **David Spanton's** lightweight Sussex 244p per kilo and grossed **£1268.80**. Nothing wrong with that - why not support the auction system?

Up, up and away - what a trade! In orbit traditional bred sorts all hitting the high spots. **Tom Rea's** Aberdeen Angus x has top call at 189p per kilo. He also has Hereford x at 188p per kilo and purebred Sussex at 187p per kilo, grossing **£1512**, **£1240.80** and **£1402.50** respectively. **Waters Partnership** has purebred Sussex at 186p making **£1311.30**. **Devil's Dyke Farm** has heavyweight Aberdeen Angus x at 179p per kilo, grossing **£1458.85**.
