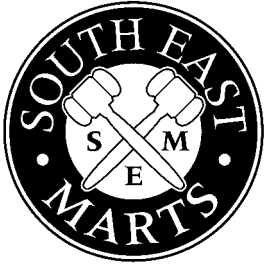
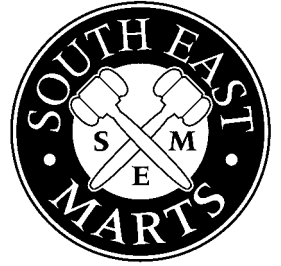

Livestock Auctions/COVID-19

Updated 22.07.21

All Covid-19 restrictions lifted
however we still must take precautions to prevent
the spread of the Corona virus!

When in a group, advice is that face coverings still be worn to protect yourself and others.

We all have to learn to live with the corona virus in future and take steps to reduce the risk of an outbreak and possibly market closure. We therefore ask that all customers co-operate and continue to respect the rules to ensure our livestock markets can remain open at this busy and vital time of year.

We ask that all prospective buyers sanitise on entry to the market and again on exiting the market. Disposable masks, gloves will be available to all. Buyers on collecting their invoices from the market office do so only by adopting the two metre rule - we ask simply that only one purchaser should collect their invoice in the usual area, queuing 2 metres apart.

Both vendors and buyers are permitted to attend livestock sales.
If at all possible, ONLY bona-fide buyers allowed in the pen allies.
Remember SOCIAL DISTANCING where possible & stay
2 METRES APART.

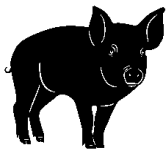

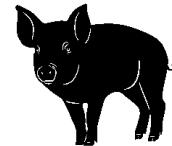

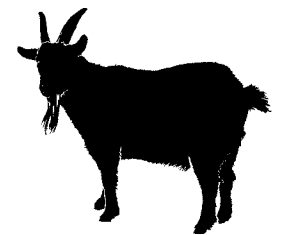
