PRIME CATTLE (UNDER AGE & OVERAGE) (17) *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

The Sussex breed reigns supreme once again. Poynings Grange Farm's medium weight to 190p and grosses £1,168. RG Standen and Son have Simmental cross steers at 165p and heifers at 166p.

CULL COWS (9) - *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

Cull trade easing as it is elsewhere. FP Russell Farms' heavyweight Aberdeen Angus cross to 112p and £810 per head. Waters P'ship have Sussex cross cow to £751. Best of the Holsteins to Graham Smith's steakers at 97p.

Once again all trading well. M & J Franklin's reared Aberdeen Angus steers, 6 mos to £420 and heifers £340. Reared Holstein, 10 mos to £170. Young calves - Aberdeen Angus cross bulls £170, £150, £147, etc. and heifers £137 twice. Hereford cross heifers £130. Best of the black and whites to G & R Bailey's bull £90 at 6 weeks.

MILK LAMBS (304)

Overall average 158p per kilo

The finished lamb trade is as sensitive as a seismograph. Finished lambs must be perfect meat to attract a premium price above the miserable national price. It appears that only the very best meated lambs are wanted, the national trade is diabolical and candidly trade today was disappointing.
