AJ Robinson & Partner's Sussex steer to 192p and M Vine's Sussex steer to 189p. Colin Broucke's Aberdeen Angus cross steer 188p. Best of the continentals to Derek Southouse's Limousin steer to 196p. Bunny Hicks led the way with his marvellous heavyweights at £96.50 in close attendance Barry Skinner from Beckley who did grand business at £84 and top price per kilo at 190.5p, proving quality counts, closely followed by Jeremy (who has the best) at 189.1p.

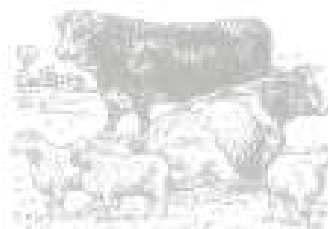
