PRIME CATTLE (UNDER AGE & OVERAGE) (15) *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

Short entry, butcher requirements not met - two pound barrier broken once again - Brian Foster's medium weight Limousin heifer at 203p. Best of the steers to Robert Page's Sussex cross at 178p. More, well finished cattle required for next week, keep in touch.

CULL COWS (18) - *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

More buyer participation moving the trade along for big and small alike. Chris French's Charolais cross cows hit the high spots 118p and 116p per kilo - £900 plus. David Spanton's Sussex to 113p and close to £800. Lean steaking cows with weight to 92p per kilo. Swedish Red cross under four to £873.

Better show of reared and younger milk calves forward. Reared Aberdeen Angus x British Friesians from M & J Franklin & Son to £405 and heifers to £370, likewise from J Cranfield & Son - Aberdeen Angus x Friesian Holstein steers £380 and heifers £370. Younger milk calves from Ford Partnership have Aberdeen Angus cross bulls to £270 and heifers to £210.
