PRIME CATTLE (UNDER AGE & OVERAGE) (6) *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

Butchers battle - Phil Norris supports with his homebred Sussex cross heifers and look well sold, real medal winners - just a shame no more here to enjoy the trade. Gold heifer weighed in at 585 kg. at 195p, Silver heifer 505 kg. at 190p and Bronze heifer 580 kg. at 173p, best heifer grosses £1,140.75.

CULL COWS (7) - *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

Virtually all plain cows straight out the dairy. Holsteins circa 65/69p all to feed on. Heavyweight Shorthorns to £686 and medium weight Hereford x Friesian 100p per kilo. Cows are wanted at Hailsham.

CALVES (34) - *Auctioneer: Roger Waters*

Not the keenness of last week and a large variation in quality, however all sold well. Mrs MEH Pile & Son's Aberdeen Angus cross bull £250 and heifer £120, A & J Griffiths' part reared Aberdeen Angus cross bull £225, G & R Bailey's Friesian Holstein bulls to £75. Top five young Holstein Friesian bulls £41, £40, £40, £39 and £39, many others circa £35 - £18 price range.

It is said that "by the sweat of thy brow thou shalt eat bread", this was definitely very true today with the temperature hitting 34°, the infrastructure and management struggled to cope with good numbers on offer. The price didn't suffer - it was beyond the national trade and we are justifiably proud considering other centres were reporting a 10p per kilo reduction across the board. The festival of Eid-ul-Adha starts on 11th September, it is strongly recommended if you have sheep to sell the time is now.
