Sussex reign supreme - Brian Walker's purebred steer changes hands at 194p and Paul Rossi's lightweight heifer in the frame at 188p. Good to see Messrs. Flower & Lawrence's medium weight Continental cross to 185p and £1,200 plus - a good depth of trade.

CULL COWS (12) - Auctioneer: Roger Waters

Spirited competition on all classifications. Norman Harman's medium weight Simmental cross cow to 120p and close to £800. Norwegian Red cross to £710+.

Lean steaking Friesian Holsteins to 99p. Many cows sold to feed on 77/90p price range. Belted Galloways to 93p per kilo!
